Year 9 and 10 students from refugee and migrant backgrounds in Tasmanian Government schools.

Aim High delivers weekly study support sessions at Migrant Resource Centre Tasmania, 1A Anfield St Glenorchy. Volunteers are available to drive participants home after sessions using the MRC Tas bus.
